OMNI BRASS TO PERFORM FOR HOUSTON SYMPHONY LEAGUE BAY AREA



The first monthly meeting of the 2013 – 2014 HSLBA season will be held on Wednesday, September 11, 2013, at the Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Nassau Bay, Texas. At 10:00 a.m. there will be socializing, followed by a brief business meeting at 10:30 a.m. and an OMNI BRASS performance at 10:45 a.m.

OMNI BRASS will present a diverse program of traditional repertoire combined with innovative arrangements of music in all styles. Included will be Andrea Gabrieli's *Ricercar*, Maurice Ravel's *Trois Chanson*, Antonin Dvorak's *Humoresques*, Alberto Ginastera's *Malambo*, and the well-known Dixieland favorite *Basin Street Blues*.

OMNI BRASS was founded (under the name Prism Brass) in 2006 by trombonist Karen Marston. Since that time, the ensemble has combined an active freelance career in and around the Houston area with significant recital events focused on expanding the repertoire for brass quartet. In 2008, members of OMNI BRASS were quarterfinalist finishers in the *Fischoff International Chamber Music Competition* and were featured in a *Soiree Recital* at that event. OMNI has also performed well-received programs at Rice University, the San Jacinto College Central Brass Symposium, St. Paul Catholic Church, and St. Pius Catholic Church, and can regularly be heard performing on Sunday mornings at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. In 2012, the ensemble made their international debut as featured guest artists at *Café Corotu*, an innovative concert series in Panama City, Panama. Active supporters of new works, OMNI recently performed the world premier of Joseph Schenck's *Fanfare Aprilis Mensis*, a piece written for the group, and can be heard on the first recording of Paul Busselberg's new work for brass, choir, percussion, and organ, *Songs of Mercy*. Currently, the members of OMNI are recording a debut CD, a project that which has been funded through a successful *Kickstarter* Campaign.

Guests are welcome and membership is open to those who enjoy music and want to support and promote music of the Houston Symphony. HSLBA also brings music enrichment to all CCISD students in grades one through five throughout the school year. For information, please call Pat Biddle at 281-488-2346.
